Volunteers enable us to offer training at a lower cost. Each volunteer is at least 18 years old, commits to at least 40 hours of labor per week, and is guided by a department supervisor.

Volunteering at Faith Builders is also a way to train and prepare for a lifetime of Christian service. In addition to receiving on-the-job training and skills development, volunteers participate in weekly mentoring groups. The formative discipleship of mentoring helps to deepen commitment to Christ and His church.
